Meals and Food

- Provide Meals for Teen Open Door Nights
- Provide Dessert for monthly parents nights out
- Pick up fruits and vegetables and bag them on Monday mornings
- Deliver Thanksgiving meals
- Provide meals for families in the midst of crisis
- Deliver food to families as it is available

Provide professional services like

- Basic car repairs
- Electrical work
- Plumbing repairs
- Other specialty work _____

Emotional support

- Take an adult out for coffee/tea and dessert (mentor adults)
- Visit a family in the home and befriend them

Programs

- Attend Parents nights out to build relationships with adults
- Join volunteer staff on Monday or Thursdays

General

- Provide transportation to doctors or counselors
- Provide transportation for job interviews
- Help create resume and upload it online
- Provide basic needs for families in dire circumstances (crock pots, toasters, gas cards, etc)
